

Communication

- Providing access to information in multiple, redundant formats
- Providing auxiliary aids and services as necessary

Medical

- Providing basic medical care and assistance for individuals who require on-going treatment but may lack adequate support for activities such as tube feeding, suction administration, and wound care
- Referring individuals with severe and acute medical needs

Independence

- Replacing Durable Medical Equipment (DME) and Consumable Medical Supplies (CMS) necessary for daily living
- Permitting service animals and personal attendants or caregivers to enter

Supervision

- Ensuring persons with cognitive disabilities are appropriately cared for and receive individualized service coordination and case management

Transportation

- Organizing community transit resources with concern for the need and appropriate use of adaptive vehicles
